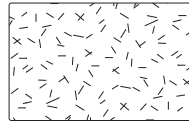




KITSCH-NITSCH[®] application instructions

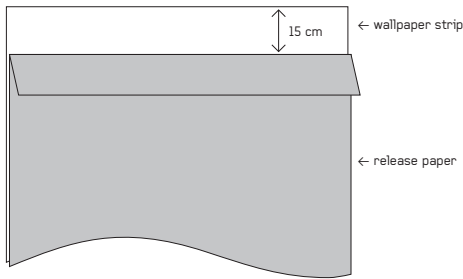

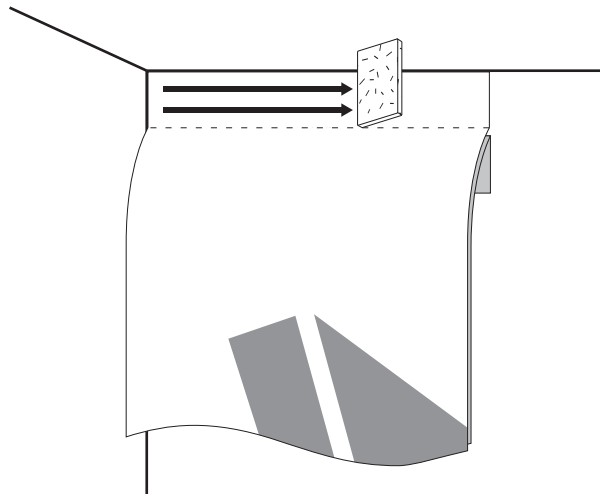

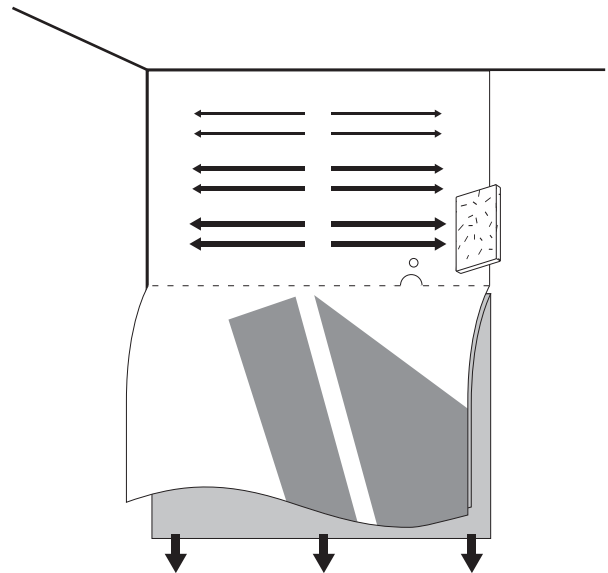
- 1 Wallscapes are cut to strips. Take them out of the packaging and lay them down on the floor. Arrange them in the appropriate order. Apply the strip on the far left (or right) first. Strips are self-adhesive. Measure the Wallscapes against the wall carefully, since the strong glue does not allow for much correction. **Apply the strips next to each other with 5 mm overlap!** Two people are needed for successful application.



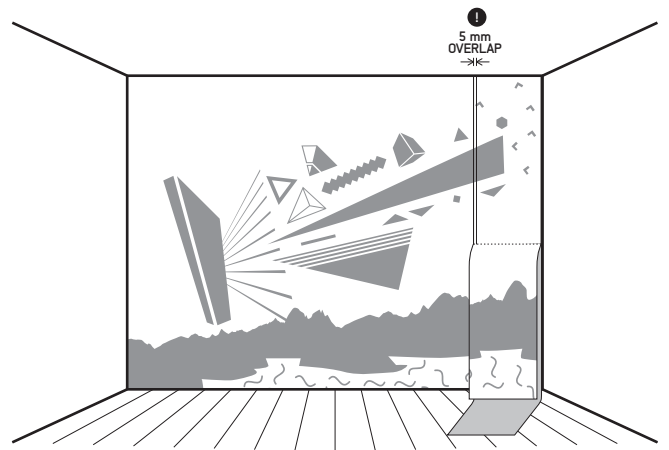
- 1 Place the Wallscapes strip face down on the floor. Fold back a 15 cm belt of the release paper.



- 2 Apply the first part of the artwork (start in the top left or right corner of the selected surface). Secure the top part of the artwork to the wall with strong left to right squeegee moves.



- 3 Continue by using firm strokes leading from the center to the sides of the artwork. Be careful to squeeze out all the air bubbles. Simultaneously pull down the release paper slowly and evenly.



- 4 Repeat steps 1 - 3 until your artwork is finished. Remember: there is a 5 mm vertical overlap between two strips. Afterwards use a mitten to additionally secure the Wallscapes to the surface.

Apply to flat, clean and dry surfaces. Vinyl is thick and soft. Any irregularities on walls such as cracks or bulges will be visible if not repaired or removed. Apply to walls free of dust and painted with standard wall paints. Do not apply to surfaces painted with concrete acrylic paints or paints that include metallic particles. Vinyl Wallscapes are not reusable. Vinyl gets irreparably damaged if removed. Avoid application in other than room temperature (18 - 25 °C). Avoid application in cold rooms that will be heated immediately after application (and vice versa).
